Stop disability benefit cuts!

The government is proposing massive cuts to disability benefits. These will affect more than a million PIP claimants. They are also proposing taking away Universal Credit health payments entirely for people under the age of 22.

These cuts will not help disabled people into work, or save money. It will cost money. It will cause poverty. It will remove support from disabled workers and make it harder for us to do our jobs. Removal of PIP will also take carers allowance away from 150,000 carers.

If the government really wants to support disabled workers, they need to drop the proposals and start again, listening to disabled people and carers.

Disabled people are being insulted and ignored

Labour MPs and government ministers have compared disability benefits to “children’s pocket money”. The MP for Swansea West called us “keyboard warriors”, a “burden”, then publicly called us liars.

There is a single public consultation event in Cardiff for the whole of Wales, with limited tickets and no option to join virtually. Half of the proposals - the most important ones - are not even part of the consultation. Disabled people contacting the consultation organisers asking about their access requirements, to plan their journey and accommodation, have repeatedly been ignored. The government is so scared of protest that people who have signed up won’t be told the venue until the last minute. We are protesting anyway (see back of leaflet).

Cardiff and Valleys Disabled People Against Cuts (DPAC) are fighting for a fair and respectful public debate, where disabled people can share their concerns directly, rather than being ignored, spoken for, or insulted by MPs who do not understand the issues.

We’re in this together

When the cuts were announced, we knew we wouldn’t be the only ones affected. Sure enough, this government of divide-and-rule encouraged a wave of reaction against trans people and migrants, and is attacking public sector pay and services.

The fact that a so-called Labour party could act this way must spark an urgent debate about working-class political representation.
